## **Our Camp Program Includes....**

### **Daily Riding Instruction:**

Students will ride each morning for approximately 2 hours of group instruction focusing on both flat work and jumping skills. We will have a flatwork session, gymnastics session, course work session, games, and trail riding day.

### **Trail Riding:**

We will trail ride and lesson in the field. Students will have the opportunity to experience cross country riding and jumping. Weather permitting, we will trail ride at Bucks County Horse park each session.

### **Showing:**

Students will have an opportunity to manage and participate in a horse show during camp. We will learn about judging, course design and show preparation.

## **Limited Enrollment!**

In order to provide the best experience and most hands on participation, camp will be limited to 10 students this year.

### **Horsemanship:**

Dr. Joann Vechionne will lecture on horse health topics. Clinics by area professionals will be offered on various health topics such as vaccination, farrier skills, equine massage, chiropractic, acupuncture, dentistry, Reiki etc. Students will be exposed to all facets of horse care, stable management and horse showing through these hands-on lectures.

### **What to bring?**

Students should wear appropriate riding attire and pack a lunch each day. On show and clinic days, students are asked to wear boots and breeches and a polo or riding show shirt.

## **Dates and Hours:**

2017 Dates are: June 18-22 and July 16- July 20.

Camp runs Monday through Friday from 9-3.

Tuition is \$450 for the session. ALL clinic, horse park and showing fees are included in camp tuition. A \$50 per additional session discount will be offered for campers attending multiple weeks

\*\*This is an advanced camp for mature students. Participants must be able to tack and untack independently, ride safely at the walk, trot and canter and over courses of small jumps.

The afternoon lectures will include mature content provided in a scientific manner on animal husbandry and healthcare, so parents should be sure their children are comfortable with these topics.\*\*
